

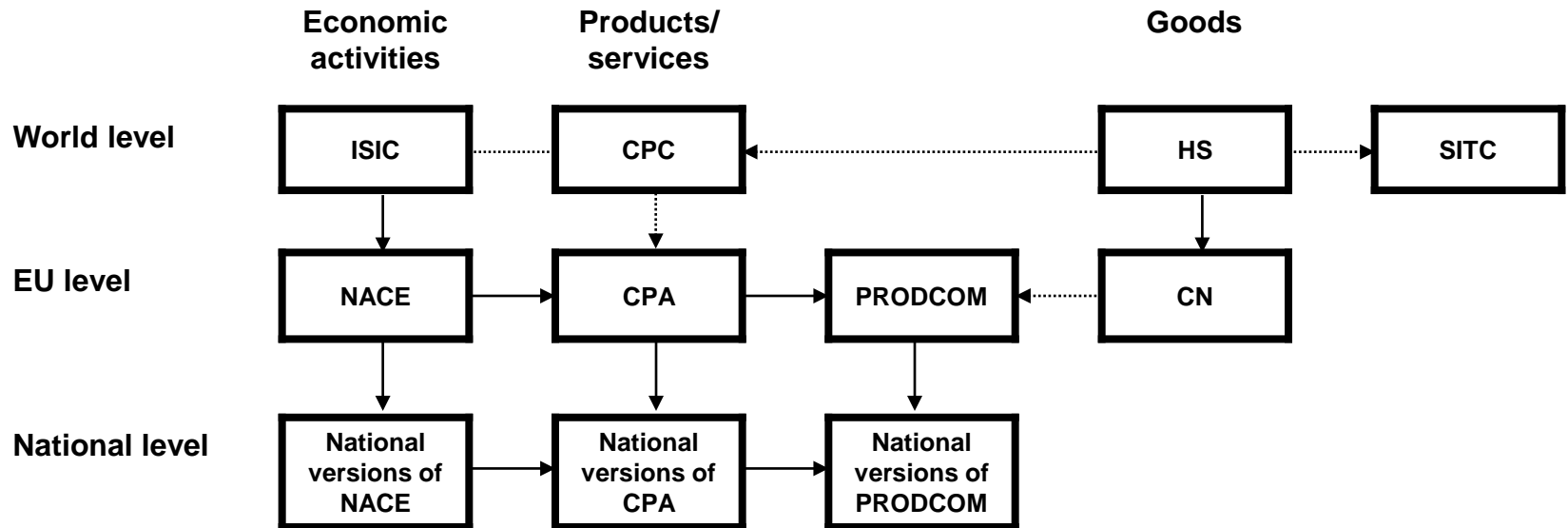

Characteristics of a statistical classification

Statistical classifications are characterised by:

- a. exhaustive coverage of the observed universe;
- b. mutually exclusive categories: each element should be classified in only one category of the classification;
- c. methodological principles which allow the consistent allocation of the elements to the various categories of the classification.

Characteristics of an activity classification

- cover **all** activities, goods and services
 - **no distinction between "legal" and "illegal" activities, goods and services**
- cover also unofficial activities
- are neutral to technology (i.e. use of IT)
- no distinction as to production methods (i.e. automatized (such as by robots) vs. "by hand")
- no distinction as to production volumes, turnover or number of staff
- no distinction between for example environmentally friendly or "traditional" processes and products
- are not demand or end use based

PHS sector coverage

- No harmonized EU data on households as employers
 - SBS (Structural Business Statistics) covers NACE Rev. 2 divisions 49.42, 56.2, 81.21, 96.01, 96.02, but excludes micro-enterprises!
- Administrative data is to some extent collected at national level
 - But, not covering the same areas!
- Examples:
 - France - PEA = Produit particuliers employeurs périodes anonymisées (EN: Annual dissemination product on employment and wage data for employees of individual employers)
 - Germany - Statistik der Bundesagentur für Arbeit

Update of NACE Rev. 2

- NACE Rev. 2 dates from 2006.
- Changes in the economic structures and organization, as well as technological developments, have introduced new activities.
- Several EU Member States have pointed out that the relevance of NACE Rev. 2 is diminishing and that some parts of the classification no longer reflect the economy of today.
- In response, Eurostat have conducted a first consultation of the EU Member States on the needs for change.
- +/- 400 proposals of changes.
- Next step: Go-ahead from the UNSD
- Time frame: 3-5 years from start of process

Update of NACE Rev. 2 - proposals

France:

- Three classes largely cover personal service activities: activities of households employing domestic services (**97.00**), home help (**88.10**) and care for young children (**88.91**). However, the field thus defined is both too broad and too narrow: it includes activities carried out outside the home (such as childcare in crèche and day-care centres), while many organizations are not counted because they are classified according to their activities, for example education (**85.51**, **85.52**, **85.59**), tutoring (**85.59**), or home computer support (**62.09**). It is therefore difficult to identify undertakings producing personal services from the usual sources and the NACE classification.

Update of NACE Rev. 2 - proposals

Germany:

- Due to demographic reasons and economic changes there is an increasing importance of household service activities like cleaning, cooking, laundering, child care etc., offered as a broad set or bundle of support activities.
 - Create a new class for **non-specialised household service activities**.
