- More than 930 organizations and 2300 social services
- Residential services
- Home care
- Social prevention



## **Union of the employers' associations**

- More than 7.300 organizations
- More than 700.000 employees
- Covering all social sector, health care sector, education, culture and othe public services

## CURRENT SITUATION IN THE CZECH REP.

### ➤ **Personal and household services are provided via:**

- Home care (social home care – carers)
- Home care (health home care – nurses)
- Private entrepreneurs and companies
  - With free trading licence
  - Since 2014 household services only



# „SOCIAL“ HOME CARE

- Number of services: 747
- Number of employees: 3.200 employees
- Number of clients: cca 115.000 clients
  
- *Czech Rep. – 10,5 mil. inhabitants*



# „SOCIAL“ HOME CARE - CONTENT

- Meals on wheels
- Household services
  - Cleaning, shopping, offices
- Personal care
  - Assistance of daily living activities



# „HEALTH“ HOME CARE

- Number of providers: 472
- Number of employees: 3.000
- Number of clients: cca 147.000 clients
- Number of home visits: 5,9 mil.
  
- *Czech Rep. – 10,5 mil. inhabitants*



# „HEALTH“ HOME CARE - CONTENT

- Nursing care, defined by responsibilities of a general nurse, pediatric nurse, nurse specialized in a particular specialty (for example care of stoma).
- Rehabilitation care, defined by responsibilities of a physiotherapist or ergotherapist .
- Care, therapy and conciliar advice provided in response to the client's momentary health and mental condition by relevant physicians of different medical specialties.





## The PHS concept in the Czech Rep.

- Occasional occupation – project in 2003 (similar to LEA system). Pilot in three dept.
  - Not further used because of low enemployment
- 2012, EFSI conference
- September 2013, Priority of the winning political party (titre services)
- October 2013, Round table with experts and high interest of media

## The PHS concept in the Czech Rep.

- November 2013, Feasibility study of PHS in the Czech Rep.
- December 2013, a pilot project, Labour office
- February 2013, International conference in the Senat.
- UZS CR intention:
  - TITRE and LEA implementation in 2015
    - Titre has higher priority

## PHS in the Czech Rep. – considered benefits

- Lower unemployment rate
- Black market share reduction
- New benefit for employees (by employers)
  - Using the private means (from corporate profits after taxation)
- Higher specialization by home care
